How many lions and tigers are there **altogether**?

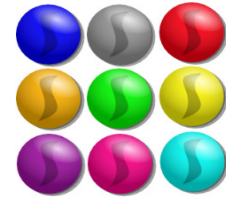


Question 4

How many bananas did I have **left**?

There are 80 **zebras and lions** in a zoo. There are 20 zebras.
How many lions are there?

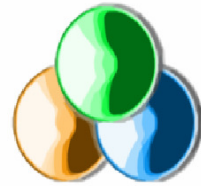


Question 10
